

Trench Inspection Step by Step Process

- Ditchers and builders call Black Hills Energy to request inspection for primary or secondary conduit system/trench. Contact one of the following utility constructions specialists or planners:

- 2. Black Hills Energy will schedule the inspection. Please allow 48 hours for inspection; actual time will vary depending on volume of requests.
 - a. Please keep the inspector informed of changes in the project timeframe or delays.
 - b. If trench inspector is not onsite by the schedule inspection time, backfill may begin as communicated by inspector.
 - c. Trenches and/or conduit system that are not completed or fail inspection on the scheduled date will then have to reschedule.
- 3. After conduit system/trench has been approved, the conduit system will be proofed with a mandrel/ mouse. Half inch mule tape will then be installed at cost to the conduit system installer.
- 4. Once the mule tape has been installed, the Black Hills Energy line crew will be scheduled.
